Since the landmark sale of an uncertified example in our industry-defining 'UK Lockdown Day One' auction on 24 March 2020 (lot 506 - £2,728 ~ \$3,130), approximately a dozen more examples have surfaced. The previous year had been especially turbulent for the Royal family, not only would it endure the unhappy loss of a much loved 'Grandpa England' and founder of the House of Windsor, King George V, but then suffer the public scandal of the Abdication crisis that saw Edward VIII sacrifice his destined Royal duty in favour of marriage to American socialite and divorcee Wallis Simpson. The dedication to public duty and service for which Her Majesty the Queen is rightly lauded as having performed throughout her life, would become instilled in her from an early age. Her Majesty's devotion to her people has been witnessed not just in peacetime but also in war. Her selfless duty as a member of the Auxiliary Territorial Service during the Second World War, has been all too easily forgotten but is now rightfully remembered within the recent international celebration of her continuance as Head of State for longer than any other occupant of St Edward's Chair. 
