(x) German Military WWI, Iran, 5 Tomans on 20 Mark, 19th February 1914, serial number N.0579833, Iran's strategic location made it of great importance to both the Allied and Central Powers during the war, however, it was Germany that established a diplomatic and military mission within Iran. Despite Iran's declaration of neutrality at the outset of war in 1914, Germany utilised its mission in Iran for subversive operations and the collection of intelligence aimed at undermining British and Russian influence in the region. Through the circulation of banknotes within Iran, Germany aimed to solidify its economic power and access to Iranian resources, oil reserves being essential for Germany's military and industrial needs. The intricacy of design and vibrant colours on this banknote are captivating, originally a 20 Mark note with a red 5 Toman overprint (Pick M3, BNB 201), in PMG holder 40 Extremely Fine, corner missing, scarce Subject to 5% tax on Hammer Price in addition to 20% VAT on Buyer's Premium.

This particular stamp, exclusively in use between 1905 and 1908, was occasionally extended to 1904 and 1909 in select cases. The date of this specific 1 Toman 1st series banknote is July 11, 1907. On the reverse is serial number A/C 065681, featuring the split prefix letters, printed in red instead of the usual black. This subtle deviation not only enhances its visual appeal but also contributes to its security features. Although this banknote represents the smallest denomination within its series, which often indicates frequent use and potential wear, it has managed to maintain its remarkable condition. It stands out as the finest example of its kind within this collection (Pick 1, BNB 102, Bonine Figure 9), in PMG holder 30 Very Fine, repaired, only 3 notes in higher grade on PMG Census. 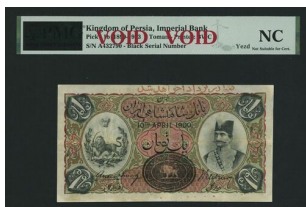

What sets this note apart is its extraordinary and distinctive design, making it stand out from all the other first Qajar series notes, especially from its more familiar variety Pick 1 with the iconic lion and sun motif. Notably, Pick A1 does not feature the iconic lion motif, but instead boldly displays the English word 'ONE' in bold capital letters encircled on the reverse. The latest edition of General Issues SCWPM, its 16th Edition, lists the year 1896 as the last date for the A1 series, suggesting that this year marks the end of the design that featured the English word 'ONE' (Pick A1, BNB 101, Bonine Figure 6). A note by the cataloguer - Regular specimen notes show up in very rare moments and you would be considered lucky if you see one in a decade. However, the issued notes (of which, there are less than a handful known to date) are usually kept in a very special place of sophisticated collectors' minds, where perhaps it remained in the far corners of their imagination when they had a chance to see it once with their own eyes in a private collection or heard a story of one extant. One of the rarest and possibly the most sought-after Persian banknotes that ever comes to grace the market, especially with as a branch issue, and no other that Bushire itself! It inaugurated its operations in June 1890 and commenced issuing banknotes specifically for the region from December 1890 until 29 March 1933. This particular banknote, produced by Bradbury Wilkinson & Co., is pink and green with its obverse showcasing Farsi text, a coat of arms with the Kiani crown, a portrait of Naser al-Din Qajar in a military uniform and fez, with symbols of a sun, lion, and sword. A stamped seal bearing black Farsi text is also prominent. The note is dated 1st November 1921, and bears the inscription "Payable at Isfahan only" in the lower centre margin. On the reverse, English text is juxtaposed with the same coat of arms. The split prefix letters and the distinctive serial number "P/C 048777" are prominently displayed at the centre, lower left, and upper right. Furthermore, it stands as the sole banknote issued for Isfahan within this impressive collection (Pick 2, BNB 103, Bonine A.2), in PMG holder 25 Very Fine, only 7 notes in higher grades on PMG Census, scarceSubject to 5% tax on Hammer Price in addition to 20% VAT on Buyer's Premium.

His dedication and passion for geography led him to earn a Ph.D., and it was during his academic endeavours that he developed a deep connection with the Iranian city of Yazd (formerly known as Yezd). In the late 1960s, Michael and his wife, Marilyn, embarked on an extraordinary journey. They set out from London, their trusty Land Rover carrying them across vast distances to the heart of the Middle East. This journey to Yezd was more than just a trip; it was the genesis of a lifelong love for travel and the start of a distinguished career as a photographer of both human and physical geography. From that first voyage, Michael's reputation for the breadth of his intellectual interests and the quality of his photographic work was firmly established. Yezd is a city that embodies a remarkable blend of history, culture and innovation. Located in the heart of the desert, its traditional adobe buildings and windcatchers (Badgirs) are ingeniously designed to provide natural cooling despite the scorching heat. Innovative water management systems, such as qanats (underground water channels), have been integral to Yezd's survival in the arid desert environment, providing vital resources for agriculture and daily life. But Yezd is more than just its architecture; it is a testament to the enduring spirit of the Zoroastrian community in Iran. The city is renowned for its significant Zoroastrian presence, with the Fire Temple at its core. Within this temple, a sacred flame named the Behram Fire has burned since 470 CE, symbolising the resilience of the faith. Yezd's historical significance extends beyond its borders. As a pivotal stop along the Silk Road, it served as a bridge for the exchange of economic and cultural influences between the East and West.
