Tri oversaw the development of Vietnam's National Army, working alongside the French forces and US ambassadors to repress the communist-led Viet Minh formed by Ho Chi Minh. During his tenure, he instigated several large-scale projects, including the establishment of guerilla forces to counter the Viet Minh's own aggressive guerilla tactics. Presented only a year before the dissolution of French Indochina under the Geneva Accords of 21st July 1954, this is the personal album of one of the three nations' most important military figures during a seminal period in the region's history. 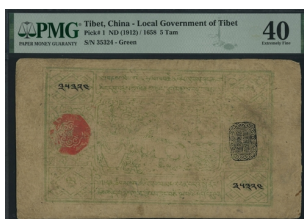
