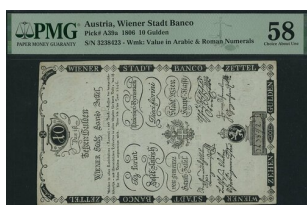

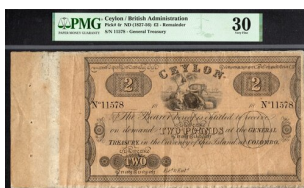

Printed in the United States by the Tudor Press of Boston and released in August 1948, it reflects both Germany's limited post-war printing capacity and the degree of Allied control over the new currency. The higher denominations of the Tudor Press series, including the 50 Deutsche Mark, were soon withdrawn due to inadequate security features and vulnerability to counterfeiting. The 50 Deutsche Mark Pick 10a is regarded as the rarest post-war German banknote, a status further enhanced when encountered in this exceptional condition.
