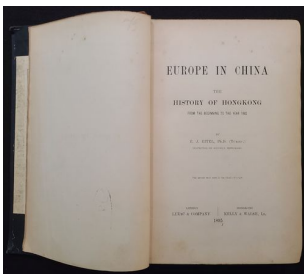

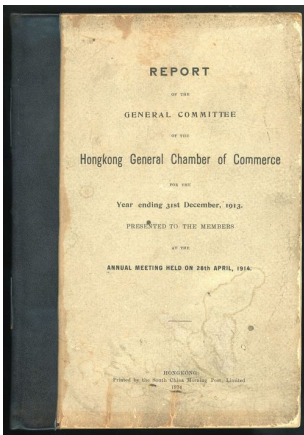

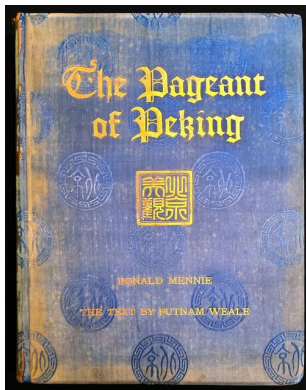

"The Pageant of Peking" includes 66 of Manny's works.They are all printed on print paper first, and then each one is pasted into the book. Pay attention to the quality of the book. The cloth cover of the spine of this book has been worn away and lost, and the cover has faded and yellowed due to age. There are also yellow spots on the pages inside the book. But there are no missing pages or loose pages.

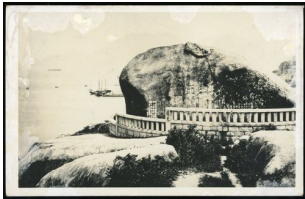

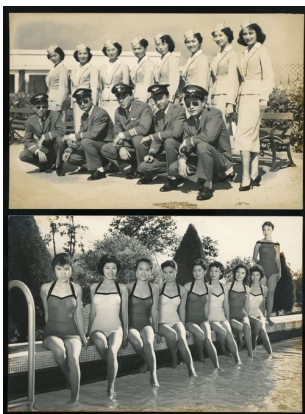

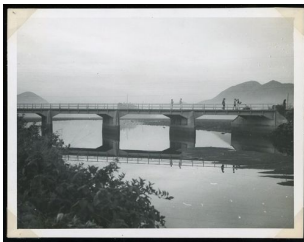

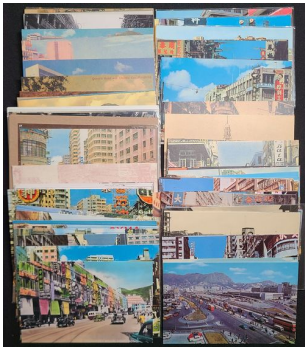

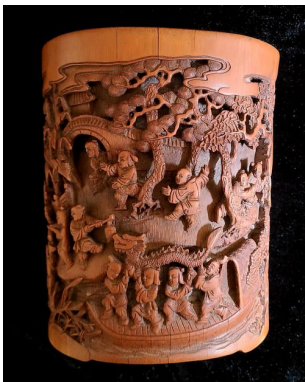
